


Who we are

We tackle global health challenges in sub-Saharan Africa through supporting **collaborative research** activities and strengthening the clinical research ecosystem.



We fund **cutting-edge clinical research and innovation** to develop new medicines, vaccines and diagnostics that can save lives across sub-Saharan Africa and around the world.


We support all phases of clinical evaluation (phases I-IV), with a particular emphasis on late-stage product development.

We also support research capacity development and networking activities, and strengthen **global health security**.

Our funding is provided through **competitive calls for proposals**. Eligible applicants must be established in:

- Member States of the European Union and their Overseas Countries and Territories
- Countries associated to the European Union's Horizon Europe programme
- Countries in Africa that are members of the EDCTP Association.

Building on success

- **EDCTP1** 2003–2015

Focused on clinical trials and research capacity on HIV/AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis.

- **EDCTP2** 2014–2024

Expanded to include neglected infectious diseases, diarrhoeal diseases, lower respiratory tract infections, and epidemic preparedness.

Global Health EDCTP32021–2031

Greater focus on later-stage clinical trials, vulnerable populations, global challenges and solutions including: epidemic preparedness, climate and health, antimicrobial resistance and digital health technologies.
