# Who we are

Established in 2021, Global Health EDCTP3 is the **largest research funding partnership** between **Europe** and **Africa**.

It brings together **the European Union**, represented by the European Commission, and the **EDCTP Association**, representing currently governments of 15 European and 31 sub-Saharan African countries.



**Global Health EDCTP3** builds on its predecessors, EDCTP1 and EDCTP2.

2003-2015

### EDCTP1

- **Legal structure:** European Economic Interest Grouping
- **Total budget:** €400 million
- **Disease scope:** HIV, TB, and malaria
- **Membership:** 16 European countries

2014-2024 (2026)

### EDCTP2

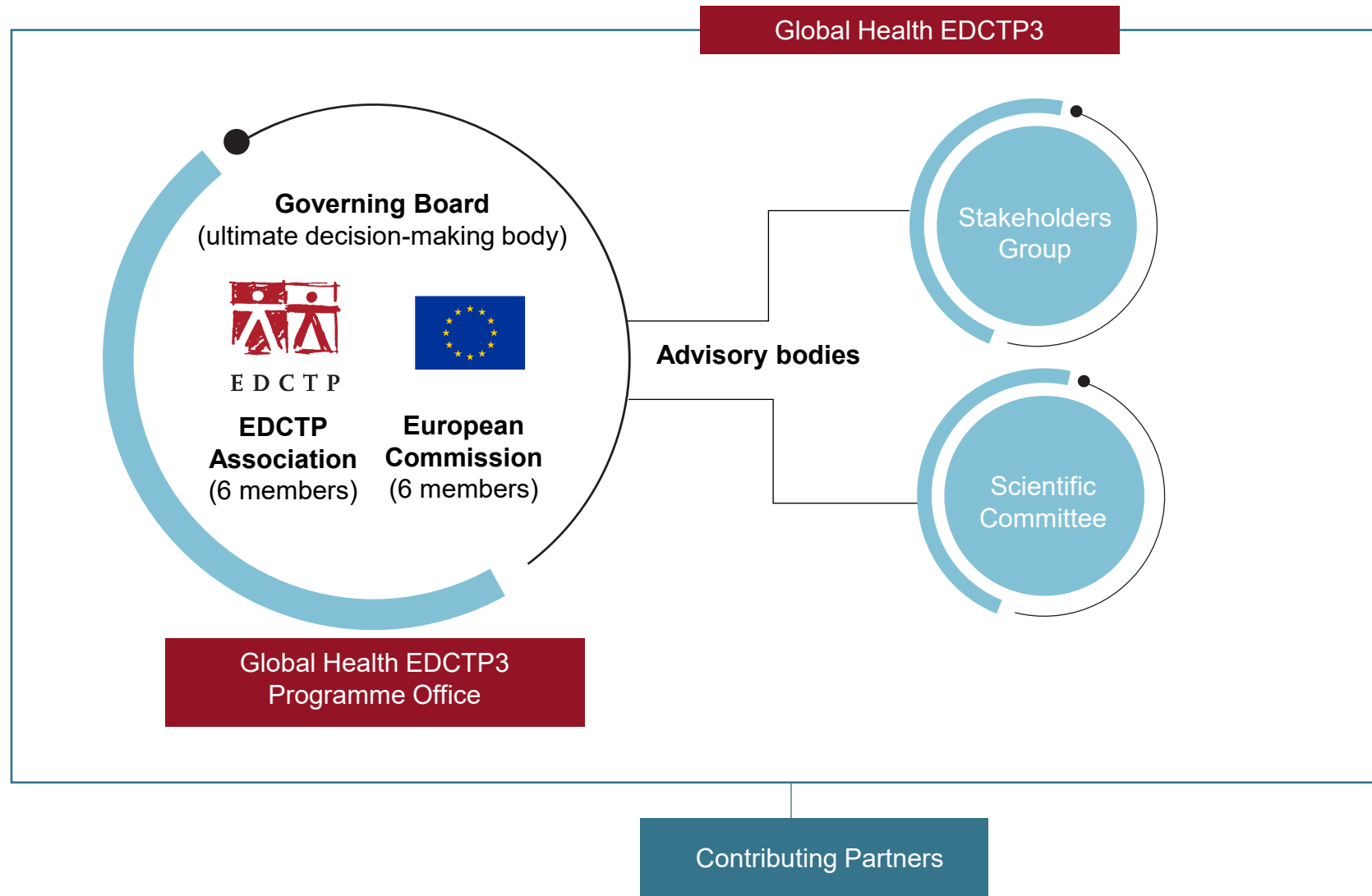
- **Legal structure:** EDCTP Association
- **Total budget:** €1.3 billion
- **Disease scope:** HIV, TB, malaria, Neglected Infectious Diseases (NIDs), diarrhoeal diseases, lower respiratory tract infections, and infectious diseases of epidemic potential
- **Membership:** 14 European countries and 16 African countries

2021-2031

### Global Health EDCTP3

- **Legal structure:** Joint Undertaking between the EU and the EDCTP Association
- **Total budget:** €1.86 billion
- **Disease scope:** HIV, TB, malaria, NIDs, diarrhoeal diseases, lower respiratory tract infections, infectious diseases of epidemic potential, antimicrobial resistance, climate-provoked infectious diseases, digital health, pandemic preparedness, and co-infections and co-morbidities with NCDs
- **Membership:** 15 European countries and 31 African countries

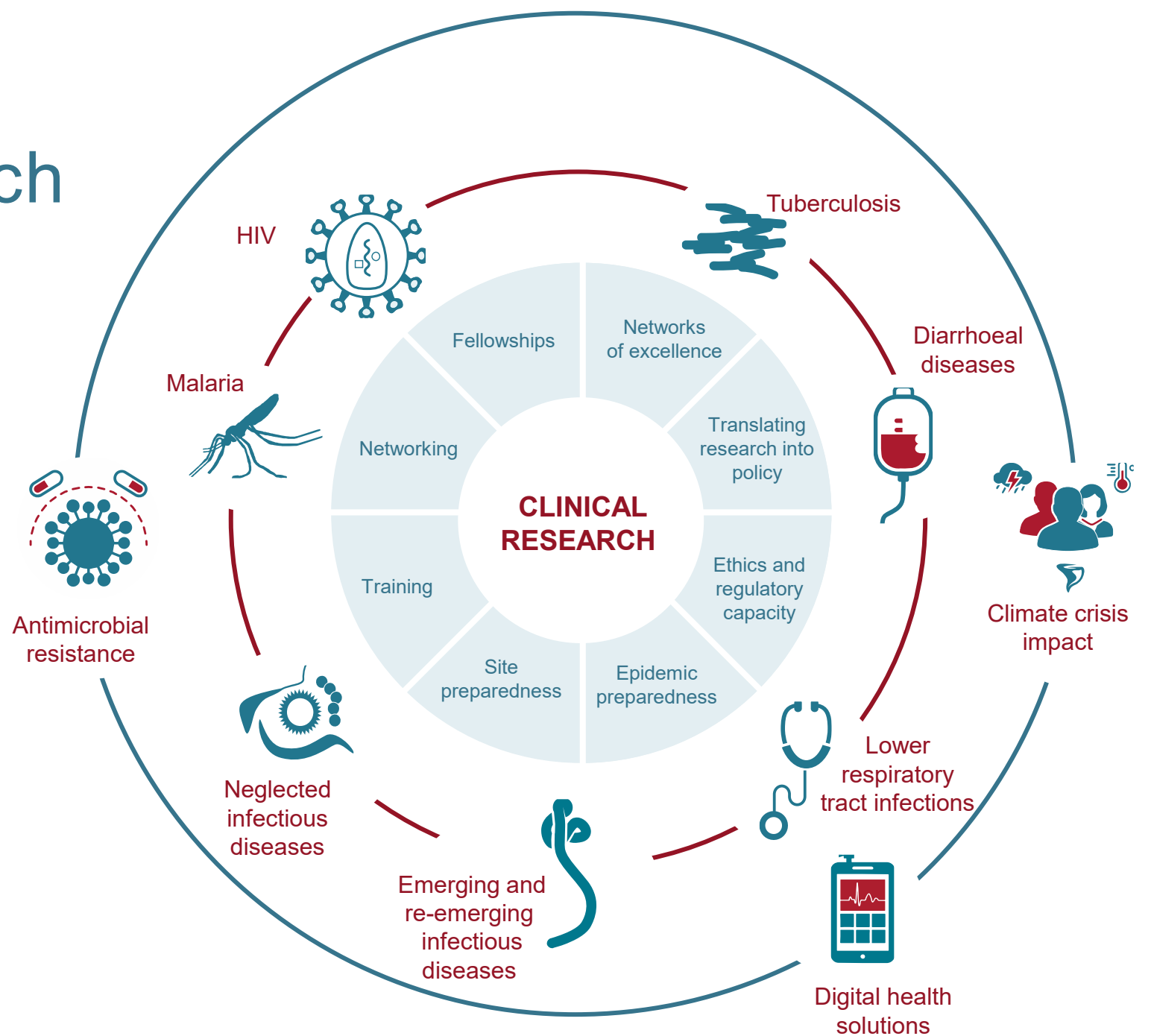

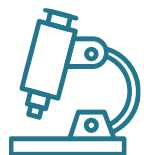
