

DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE GLOBAL HEALTH EDCTP3 JOINT UNDERTAKING N° GB 30/2022

Approving the actions selected for funding from the Identified Beneficiary Actions under the 2022 work programme

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2021/2085 of 19 November 2021 establishing the Joint Undertakings under Horizon Europe¹ and in particular Articles 17 (2) (u) and 19 (4) (j) thereof,

WHEREAS

- (1) The Governing Board had approved the annual work programme including two topics for identified beneficiary actions with Decision GB 21/2022;
- (2) The work programme includes a contribution from the contributing partner Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, accepted by the Governing Board with Decision GB 20/2022;
- (3) The identified beneficiaries were invited to submit the applications by 7 September;
- (4) The submitted proposals were evaluated by internal Commission staff who did not have a conflict of interest according to the Horizon Europe process, as defined in the eGrants Vademecum. This process was concluded 10 November 2022.

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

The selection for funding of the identified beneficiary actions "LEVERAGING AFRICAN GENOMIC SEQUENCING PLATFORMS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH IMPACT", number 101104504, EU contribution of EUR 50,000 and "Strengthening global cooperation and institutional capacities in sub-Saharan Africa to facilitate implementation of the GH EDCTP3 programme", number 101103640, EU contribution of EUR 2953000 is approved.
