



GOVERNING BOARD OF THE GLOBAL HEALTH EDCTP3 JOINT UNDERTAKING DECISION N° GB/17/2025

on adopting the Monitoring and Evaluation Framework of Global Health EDCTP3 Joint Undertaking

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE GLOBAL HEALTH EDCTP3 JOINT UNDERTAKING (hereafter “Global Health EDCTP3 JU”),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) No 2021/2085 of 19 November 2021 establishing the Joint Undertakings under Horizon Europe (hereafter “the Founding Regulation”), in particular articles 5(2)(d) and (o), 17(2)(a) and (q), 19(4)(o), 108(3)(i) and 171(2) thereof,

Having regard to the comments of the members of the Governing Board, the Scientific Committee and the Stakeholders Group,

WHEREAS:

- (1) Global Health EDCTP3's Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) framework (“the Framework”) aims to establish a systematic and structured approach to tracking Programme results across all stages of its lifecycle, providing evidence to support timely adjustments in its activity plans and strategic decision-making;
- (2) The Framework has been developed through document analysis and targeted consultations with Global Health EDCTP3 staff, the EDCTP Association, and with input from the Global Health EDCTP3 Stakeholders Group, Scientific Committee and Governing Board respective members;
- (3) The Framework is intended to serve as a living tool - flexible and adaptable - to be refined over time as Programme implementation advances, global health priorities evolve, and practical insights emerge.

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION

Article 1

1. The Global Health EDCTP3's Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) framework (“the Framework”) annexed to this decision is hereby adopted.
2. The Executive Director may make modifications to the Framework as appropriate and shall frequently inform the Governing Board about them.



Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption.
