

DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE GLOBAL HEALTH EDCTP3 JOINT UNDERTAKING N° GB 31/2022

Approving the actions selected for funding from the HORIZON-JU-GH-EDCTP3-2022-01 call for proposals

THE GOVERNING BOARD,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2021/2085 of 19 November 2021 establishing the Joint Undertakings under Horizon Europe¹ and in particular Articles 17 (2) (u) and 19 (4) (j) thereof,

WHEREAS

- (1) The Governing Board had approved the annual work programme including the topics for the call for proposals HORIZON-JU-GH-EDCTP3-2022-01 with Decision GB 21/2022;
- (2) The work programme includes a contribution from the contributing partner Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, accepted by the Governing Board with Decision GB 20/2022;
- (3) The call for proposals HORIZON-JU-GH-EDCTP3-2022-01 was launched on the Funding & Tenders Portal of the EU on 11 May 2022 and closed on 30 August 2022;
- (4) The evaluation using independent experts according to the Horizon Europe process as defined in the eGrants Vademecum was concluded 10 November 2022. Ranking and as relevant reserve lists are proposed for the five topics under the HORIZON-JU-GH-EDCTP3-2022-01 call;
- (5) The previously launched written procedure for approving GB Decision GB 29/2022 (ARES(2022)7821887) could not be approved;
- (6) The peer review experts considered participation of legal entities from several countries essential as recorded in the Evaluation Summary Reports;
- (7) The participation of legal entities located in the United Kingdom is considered essential as explained in Annex II.

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Sole Article

The results of the evaluation and the actions selected for funding for the five topics of the HORIZON-JU-GH-EDCTP3-2022-01 call for proposals as shown in the table in Annex I are approved.

The funding for legal entities located in several countries normally not eligible for funding whose participation was considered essential by the evaluation experts is confirmed.

The funding for legal entities located in the United Kingdom whose participation is considered essential as described in Annex II is confirmed.
