1. Introduction

The protection of your privacy is of high importance to Global Health EDCTP3 Joint Undertaking (hereinafter referred to as Global Health EDCTP3 JU). Global Health EDCTP3 JU is committed to respecting and protecting your personal data and ensuring your privacy rights.

All data of a personal nature processed within the framework of the legal and financial newsletter subscription and related information for representatives of beneficiaries of Global Health EDCTP3 JU grants, namely data that can identify you directly or indirectly, will be handled fairly, lawfully and with due care.

This processing operation is subject to Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of individuals regarding the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices, and agencies and on the free movement of such data. The information in this communication is given pursuant to Articles 15 and 16 of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.

This Privacy statement provides detailed information on all types of data that can be processed in the context of the legal and financial newsletter subscription and related information by Global Health EDCTP3 JU for representatives of beneficiaries of Global Health EDCTP3 JU grants.

2. Controller/ Joint controllers/Processors

The relevant processing operation is under the responsibility of the Executive Director of the Global Health EDCTP3 JU, acting as the Data Controller. Your personal data are processed based on applicable data protection legislation by Global Health EDCTP3 JU, Avenue de la Toison d'Or 56-60, 1060 Brussels, Belgium. Global Health EDCTP3 JU has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO). The task of the DPO is to ensure, in an independent manner, that Global Health EDCTP3 JU complies with the data protection law and protects individuals' rights and freedoms by effectively protecting their personal data. The data processor is the external service provider that handles the newsletter: Mailjet (company based in 43 rue de Dunkerque, 75010 Paris, France). EU Survey is also a data processor, please find the relevant DPN [here](#).

3. Why and how do we process your personal data?

Your data is collected and processed within the framework of the legal and financial newsletter subscription and related information for representatives of beneficiaries of Global Health EDCTP3 JU. Data are processed for the purpose of subscribing to the Global Health EDCTP3 JU's electronic financial and legal newsletter and establishing a list of email addresses based on consent through EUSurvey or by sending an email to finance@global-health-edctp3.europa.eu. Each issue of the e-newsletter is sent to this list: sending emails, invitations to events, alerts, e-news, and other relevant information.

Our approach ensures that your data is managed in compliance with relevant legal and regulatory requirements, safeguarding its confidentiality and integrity while facilitating efficient and transparent operations within our organisation.



We process your personal data to send you newsletters via e-mail if you subscribed to our legal and financial newsletter and explicitly expressing your wish to receive our newsletter. As a subscriber of the legal and financial newsletter, your personal data is processed by the Global Health EDCTP3 JU to allow us to establish a list of email addresses to which each issue of the e-newsletter is sent, to send emails and invitations to events, alerts, e-news, and other relevant information relevant to legal and financial matters and to collect statistics to improve the quality of the newsletter.

Your personal data will not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling.

By managing these data carefully, the process ensures compliance with relevant regulations and standards, while striving to maintain transparency, efficiency, and impartiality in selecting qualified individuals for these roles.

Your personal data will not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling.

4. Categories of data subjects

The data subjects involved in this processing are representatives of the beneficiaries of Global Health EDCTP3 JU grants, having requested or explicitly consented to be part of the Global Health EDCTP3 JU database and to receive emails, invitations to events, alerts, e-news, newsletters and other relevant information from the Global Health EDCTP3 JU on legal and financial matters.

5. Which personal data do we collect and further process and on which legal grounds?

When you subscribe to our newsletter, we process the following data you provide us with:

- Identity information, such as your first name and last name;
- Contact details, such as your e-mail address;
- Name of organisation that is beneficiary of Global Health EDCTP3 JU that you represent;
- Global Health EDCTP3 JU project to which your organisation participates.

We receive most of your personal data directly from you. If we receive personal data about you from a third party, we will inform you about this or ask the third party to inform you about this.

In particular, the lawfulness for processing the above data for the use of the legal and financial newsletter is Explicit consent Article 5.1(d) of Regulation 2018/1725. For further use for statistical purposes the lawfulness is Public interest Article 5.1(a) of Regulation 2018/1725. The specific legal basis of the processing is Council Regulation (EU) 2021/2085 of 19 November 2021 establishing the Joint Undertakings under Horizon Europe, including Global Health EDCTP3 JU, in particular Article 19(6).

By adhering to these frameworks, we ensure that all personal data is processed lawfully, transparently, and with respect to the rights and privacy of the individuals involved.

6. Who has access to your personal data and to whom is it disclosed?

The accessibility of personal data is strictly controlled based on the type of data and the purpose for which it is processed. Access to this data is granted solely on a need-to-know basis, ensuring that only authorized personnel within Global Health EDCTP3 JU staff members have the ability to view or handle the information. This policy helps to protect the confidentiality and integrity of your data, minimizing the risk of unauthorized access.



Global Health EDCTP3 JU legal and financial team has access to your data. We also rely on the external service provider Mailjet for the registration and management of subscriptions to our newsletter.

Third parties are only allowed to process your personal data on our behalf and upon our explicit written instruction. We also warrant that all those third parties are selected with due care and are committed to observing the safety and integrity of your personal data.

We do not send your personal data in an identifiable manner to any other third party than the ones mentioned above without your explicit consent to do so. However, we may send anonymized data to other organizations that may use this data for improving our activities or services.

7. How long do we retain your personal data?

Your personal data are processed for the time of the setup of the Joint Undertaking ending on 31 December 2031 or up until such time where you withdraw your consent for processing them.

8. How to withdraw your consent and the consequences of doing this?

You have given consent to the processing of your personal data for the present processing operation when you subscribed to the newsletter of the Global Health EDCTP3 JU newsletter (Article 5(1)(d) Regulation (EU) 2018/1725).

You can withdraw your consent to the newsletter subscription at any time by sending an email to the DPO at: data-protection@global-health-edctp3.europa.eu or to finance@global-health-edctp3.europa.eu

Please note that withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of any processing based on your consent before this consent is withdrawn.

9. How do we protect and safeguard your personal data?

The Global Health EDCTP3 JU implements the following technical and organisational measures to safeguard your personal data: staff dealing with this processing operation is designated on a need-to-know basis; appropriate technical and organisational security measures, giving due regard to the risks inherent in the processing and to the nature of the personal data concerned.

10. Transfer to a third country or international organisation

The Global Health EDCTP3 JU processes your personal data within the European Economic Area (EEA) and does not transfer it to a third country or international organisation.

We rely on the external service provider Mailjet for the registration and management of subscriptions to our newsletter. This service provider is based in France and explicitly states its GDPR compliance with its [Mailjet Personal Data Protection and Privacy Policy | Mailjet](#)

11. What are your rights and how to exercise them?

As 'data subject' you have, under Chapter III (Articles 14-25) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725, specific rights. In particular:

- You have the right to request access to all personal data processed by us pertaining to you.
- You have the right to rectification, i.e., to ask that any personal data pertaining to you that are inaccurate, be corrected.
- You have the right to withdraw your consent for processing of your personal data.



- You have the right to erasure, i.e., to request that personal data pertaining to you be deleted if these data are no longer required in the light of the purposes outlined above in Heading 3.
- You have the right to restriction instead of deletion, i.e., to request that we limit the processing of your personal data.
- You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing of data, including profiling, if such decision has legal effect on him or her, except for certain situations, such as entering a contract (as required by articles 14-16 & 24 of the Regulation (EU) 2018/1725).
- You have the right to data portability, i.e., to receive from us in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format all personal data you have provided to us if the processing is based on your consent or a contract with you and the processing is carried out by automated means.

Possible restrictions as laid down in Article 25 of the Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 can apply based on [Global Health EDCTP3 JU Governing Board decision n°18/2023](#) laying down internal rules concerning restrictions of certain rights of data subjects in relation to processing of personal data in the framework of the functioning of the Global Health EDCTP3 JU, in particular Articles 3(1)(k), (h), (g) and (j). Moreover, restriction already foreseen in the EU Financial Regulation, in particular Article 142.

The European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS)
